Ways to Donate to St. Paul Denver ECC

There are so many ways to donate to St. Paul. You can always write a check! Unfortunately, Amazon has discontinued their Smile Amazon program. But see below for other ways to donate.

Zelle

Most major banks have a **Zelle** function. Log into your bank account, go to Transfer or Pay and **Zelle** should be in that menu. Then all you need to do is open up **Zelle**, put **St. Paul Catholic Community ECC** in the Search box and it should pop up. Follow instructions on site and make sure you confirm the donation. The donation shows up almost immediately in the First Bank account and in your checking/savings account. The other advantage to **Zelle** is that you can schedule recurring payments.

Pay Pal

A PayPal option is available on our website. https://www.stpauldenverecc.com/. You will need to have a PayPal account. Click the Give tab. There is a rectangular blue box at bottom of the site and you just have to click on it and go directly to PayPay. PayPal does charge a small fee for service which is taken out of the donation.

King Soopers

King Soopers community rewards program: King Soopers will provide a 5% rebate on your purchases if you sign up for this program. In order to sign up for this program, there are two things you need--an online King Soopers account and a loyalty card.

- To set up an on-line account, go to http://www.kingsoopers.com. You will be asked to create a password, then information such as your email address, phone number, etc. Once you are signed into your account, here's how you link our church for this benefit:
 - On the right side of the screen click under your name, and a drop down menu will come up.
 - o Click on "My Account"
 - o Then, on the left side of your screen, there will be a menu. The last item on the list is "Community Rewards."
 - Once you are in "Community Rewards," you will be able to search for St Paul Catholic Community ECC Church, then click on it (or you can use our account ID which is WM870), and then click ENROLL.
- Note: You will need to link your loyalty card to your on-line account. To do this, using the left side drop down menu under "My Account," click on "Profile." At this screen, you will be able to add your loyalty card number. If you have set up a new King Soopers account and don't have a loyalty card, you will need to get a King Soopers rewards card at the store, then sign into your account again and add your card number in your profile.
